
Class 1 & 2 FS1 & FS2

Personal, social and emotional development

The children are going to continue their work around managing feelings and behaviour and begin to learn about taking care of the world around us including animals.



Farm animals

Literacy—reading and writing

This half term in FS1 we will be sharing non fiction books and discussing their importance and how we use non fiction books to find information.

In FS2 we will be attempting to write simple sentences to describe their experiences and we will be reading the story "What the ladybird heard" and retelling this story. The children will continue to learn all the remaining sounds in Phase 3 phonics and are to be encouraged to recognise these in their reading books.

Mathematics

In maths in FS1, we will be singing number rhymes and recognising numbers in our environment. In FS2 we will be continuing our work on composition of numbers to 10 and subitising; using this knowledge to add and subtract.





Physical development

Our PE day this half term for FS 1 & FS2 is still a **Wednesday** please come in full PE kit and the children will stay in their kit all day.

We will be continuing to learn to negotiate space, control equipment and play games in pairs and teams.

Expressive arts and design

In expressive arts and design this half term, we will be painting different animals, using animal prints and creating scenic pictures and paintings.

We will also be creating models out of Jumping Clay.

Music— In music this half term, we will be learning to make different musical sounds with our voices and sing familiar songs. We will be learning to play instruments in time to music and use music to support our free play.





In **Religious Education** we will continue to learn all about the vicar Freddie Fisher and his role in the church. We will be learning about Easter and the reasons why Christians celebrate Easter and how Christians celebrate Faster.

Understanding the world

This half term we will be learning about animals that live on a farm and the signs of new life we see in spring. The children will learn about animals and their young and the changes on the farm throughout the seasons.



Communication & Language

This half term we will be learning to share our thoughts and feelings with others and to discuss stories we have listened to. We will be asking and answering how and why questions and extending our vocabulary.
