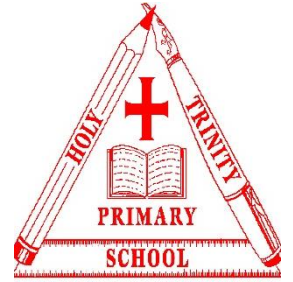

Intent: We aim to...



Develop a curiosity, love and appreciation for learning another language and discovering its culture so as to become a global citizen of the future

Develop the core 4 skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking and an early grammatical and vocabulary knowledge to engage confidently in learning a language.

Build skills that can be transferable across all language learning and as aspects of the curriculum.

Implementation: How do we achieve our aims?



Our high-quality teaching is underpinned by the KS2 National Curriculum allowing for all 4 skills to be continuously developed and key vocabulary covered.

Children are given balanced and broad opportunities to develop and understand spoken and written French. Key skills and vocabulary are revisited repeatedly and with increasing complexity, allowing children to revise and build on previous knowledge.

Lessons incorporate a range of teaching strategies involving independent tasks, paired and group work, role play, language games and language detective work. Songs, videos, on line language providers as well as specialist teaching allow for maximum engagement.



Language is initially introduced orally through repetition, games and mime allowing for oral competence and confidence prior to writing.

The cultural, traditions, history and geography form a part of the broad and rich curriculum



Where opportunity arises, comparisons are made with other languages and cultures and the varied cultural and linguistic backgrounds of the children shared and celebrated.
