

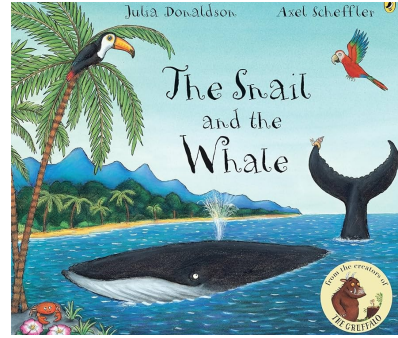
Summer 2 Curriculum Newsletter

EYFS - Class 1 & 2



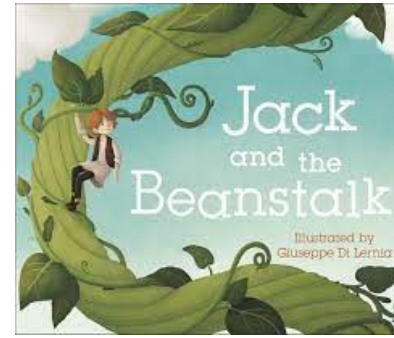
Class 1 - Under the Sea

Class 1 will be learning all about our oceans. They will learn all about the different animals that you can find living in the ocean. They will also find out about pirates and how to stay safe at the seaside.



Class 2 - How Things Grow

Class 2 will spend this term learning about growth. They will find out how to care for plants from seeds. They will also learn how they can take care of themselves so that they can grow too.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be preparing for our transition to our new classes. We will spend time in our new classrooms and with our new teachers and we will support all children through discussion and role-play in their current classes.

Literacy

Reading

Class 1 will be listening to a range of stories about sea creatures, pirates and princesses and beginning to hear initial sounds in words.

Writing

Class 1 will be working on correct letter formation using the sounds we've learnt.

Mathematics

Class 1 will continue to explore numbers and compare different quantities, saying which has more and which has less. They will also continue to use positional language and language to compare sizes.

Physical Development

Literacy

Reading

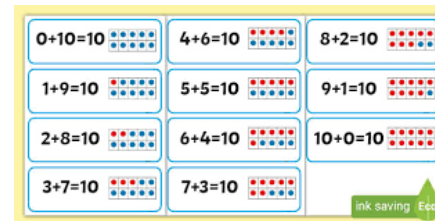
Class 2 we will be using their decoding skills to find out information about how plants grow and learning to retell the traditional tale of Jack and the Beanstalk.

Writing

The children will be applying all of the sounds and tricky words we have learnt this year to retell familiar stories and to write down facts we have learnt about how to care for plants.

Mathematics

Class 2 will be working on developing their recall of number bonds to 5 and 10. They will also learn about odd and even numbers.



Communication & Language

Speaking and listening skills are an important part of our daily routine EYFS. We will be working on expressing ourselves and discussing transition to our new classes with teachers and peers.



Expressive Arts and Design

We are encouraging the children to express their ideas in many forms, singing, moving, drawing and imaginative play.

The children will be developing their skills through role-play; retelling familiar stories and role-playing their experiences in school to make sense of them.

In **Religious Education** this term our learning will focus on awe and wonder and learning about the world around us and what God has created.



Our focus value this half term is

Understanding the World

In Class 1, the children will be learning about different animals that can be found in our oceans around the world. They will be able to name different animals and talk about how they look.

Class 2 children will be learning about the life cycles of animals and plants. We will be learning how to take care of plants and trees in our local environment and what plants and animals need to live. We will also look at how we have grown over the last year and what we need to be healthy.
