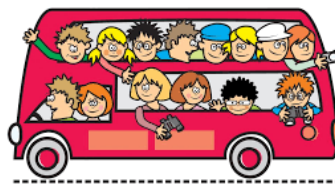


## Staying safe on line

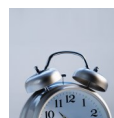
