## Personal, social and emotional development

We will be building on our resilience skills this half term, working together as a team and developing our self confidence to talk about our likes and dislikes and achievements with the rest of the class.



# Celebrations

## Literacy—reading and writing

This half term FS2 we will be exploring a variety of celebration books including Kipper's birthday by Mick Inkpen. We will be discussing how we celebrate birthdays. What are our different traditions and why we might give and receive presents.



## Mathematics

We will be continuing our work on comparing groups of identical and non-identical objects, we will be learning to subitise (know how many objects there are without counting) with numbers to 3.



## Physical development

Our PE day this half term until the end of November will be a **Wednesday then will change to a Friday** please come in full PE kit and the children will stay in their kit all day.

We will be learning to move with control and coordination in gymnastics and roll, jump and negotiate space.

We will also use our outdoor area on a daily basis to work on our climbing, balancing, negotiating space and ball skills.

## Expressive arts and design

In expressive arts and design this half term we will be making props to support our celebrations small world play. We will be making Christmas cards and designing our own wrapping paper for Santa to use in his workshop. We will continue to make our own creations daily with free access to creative resources.



## Understanding the world

This half term the children will be learning about the different festivals and religions that others follow. We will be learning how different people celebrate and thinking about what we celebrate in our own lives.

**Music** We will begin to learn to follow patterns in music and use our voices to create different sounds. We will be learning Christmas songs to sing at our EYFS Christmas carol service.



In **Religious Education** we will learn all about the vicar Freddie Fisher and his role in the church. We will learn why Christmas is an important time of year for Christians and the story of Jesus' birth.



## Communication & Language

This half term we will be taking turns in conversation, ensuring that we don't speak over other people when they are talking. We will be following simple instructions that involve 2 parts.
