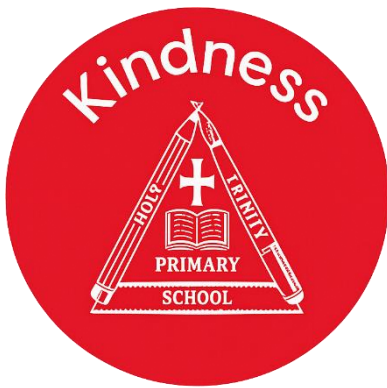
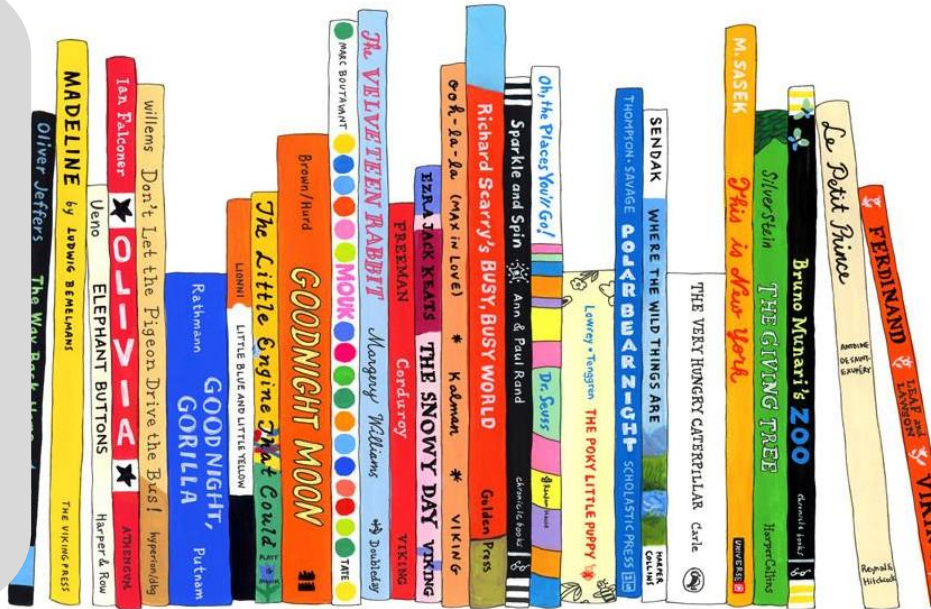


Year 3 Curriculum NEWSLETTER

English Learning

In English, we will be writing fictional narratives inspired by the Talk For Writing unit The Stone Trolls. Additionally, we will work on our sentence structure and descriptive language techniques. We will also learn to use coordinating and subordinating conjunctions to expand our sentences and add more detail to our writing. In reading, we will continue to develop our decoding, fluency and comprehension skills using VIPERS.

Maths Learning

In Maths, we will be continuing to multiply and divide, applying our times table knowledge to multiply and divide 2-digit numbers. We will continue to focus on learning the multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables, rehearsing these regularly so that we are able to recall them quickly and fluently. Additionally, we will learn to measure length and perimeter, recognizing different units of measurements and equivalent lengths.

Science - Light

In Science we will be learning about light. We will learn to identify light sources, how to stay safe in the sun and explore which materials are reflective. Additionally, we will discover how shadows are formed and investigate how shadows change throughout the day and how you can change the size of a shadow.

Geography - Biomes

In geography, we will be learning about biomes. We will learn what a biome is the different types of biomes, including deserts, forests and tundras. We will learn the location of these different biomes on a world's map and discuss why different biomes are important for plants, animals and nature.
