I would like to say thank you for all of your support with the new systems we have in place at school to help keep your children and our school community as safe as we possibly can. We are very lucky at the moment that we have had no positive test results in school. We had a COVID Secure Health and Safety Inspection last

week form the LA and he was extremely impressed by our procedures and systems in school. He said 'it was a well managed military operation to be very proud of'. Please continue to support us with our systems. There are a few things below which would help:

## Dropping off and collection of children

I know its lovely to wave your child into school, but please do leave quickly once you have dropped them off to allow the next group to move forward in the queue :-)

As per the guidance from the government, we ask that only one adult from each household hands over and collects their child/ren each day and only children of primary school age and under should accompany the adult if it is not possible for them to be at home with another responsible person.

## Reading book packs

Please return these to school every Monday morning with your child's reading record in, so we can log their weekly reads for their Rainbow Badges and to award their Trinity Pounds.

## Google Classrooms

Please support your child to complete their weekly Home Learning on their Google Classroom area. Fingers crossed we can use the Trinity Pounds you collect from completing this to pay towards an end of year visit in the summer term. It is also our way of communicating weekly about the learning going on in each classroom.

## Remote Learning

You may be aware that the Government has put measures in place for schools this week to make it a legal obligation that a Remote Learning package is in place should bubbles need to quarantine, should there need to be localised lockdowns or if there is the case to enforce a National lockdown again? I am very proud of the Remote Learning we had in place during lockdown, as this is the model the Government have advised is preferable moving forward; we are ahead of many schools. This is all thanks to Mr Hoskins setting up this system along time ago in 2013 :-). By using your Google Classroom account each week at home, you will be ready if we need to activate this learning provision again on your child's Google Classroom area:-). Fingers crossed we won't need to use this. If however we do, your child must be accessing the remote learning daily as this will be recorded in the same way as attending school and will fall under the category of unauthorised absence with fines potentially being issued if there are 5 days of these over the quarantine or lockdown period.
