


Class 1 & 2 FS1 & FS2 Space & Sea

Personal, social and emotional development

This half term will continue our work on the children's well-being and settling them back into school life—after such a long time off last term. We will also work on team building games and sharing and taking turns with one another.



Literacy

Reading- The children will experience listening to a range of books being read to them and also continue to share books on a 1-1 basis with adults to develop their decoding and blending skills in FS2.

Writing - In FS1 will be practising writing our names in a variety of ways and using the Phase 2 sounds we've learnt so far. In FS2 we will be continuing our theme of space which we moved to last half term and learning about the sea too. We will be writing captions, lists and sentences to support our learning.



Mathematics

In FS1 we will continue to explore numbers and shapes. In FS2 we will be learning about shapes and working on number bonds to 10.



Physical development

Our PE day this half term for FS2 is **Thursday** please come in full PE kit and the children will stay in their kit all day. FS1 children don't need a PE kit at this time.

We will be learning about which sports use balls and learning to control balls in a variety of different ways.

We will also use our outdoor area on a daily basis to work on our climbing, balancing, negotiating space and ball skills.

Expressive arts and design

We are encouraging the children to express their ideas in many forms, singing, moving, drawing and imaginative play.

The children will be developing their skills through designing and making space rockets and choosing appropriate materials as well as designing and making underwater creations.




Understanding the world

The children will be learning about different materials and the purposes of materials and what they can be used for. They will also be learning about outer space and the planets in the solar system. The children will then learn about our oceans and the sea life that lives there,

Music We will be using percussion instruments to explore sounds we might hear in space and creating our own space themed music.



In **Religious Education** this term our learning will focus on helping each other and the people who help us in our lives. We will use the book "Puddles Lends a Paw" to support us with this learning this term.



Communication & Language

Speaking and listening skills are an important part of our daily routine in FS1 and FS2. Listening and attention are the focus for this half term and we will be taking the time to listen to others in small groups and in 1-1 conversations with adults and peers.
